GEOGRAPHICAL ASPECTS:

The vines of Fetească Neagră grow on a slightly hilly terrain with mixed

composition of clay and limestone. **Coordinates:** 45°49'59" N, 21°35'23" E

Altitude: 220 m over sea level

Climate: Continental (-15 ° C in winter to +40 ° C in summer)

Soil: clay and limestone

Rainfall: 600 to 800 mm per year

VINEYARDS:

Variety: Fetească Neagră

Land management spring tillage and cultivation of different herbaceous

plants to enrich the soil with organic materials in autumn.

Vineyard management: the plants are managed entirely by hand and the phytosanitary treatments follow the indications of organic viticulture. During the summer the fruit load is reduced to increase the quality of the grapes.

Training system: Guyot with 5.550 plants / ha

Production: 580 ml / plant

CELLAR:

Manual harvest

Manual sorting of the bunches and berries

Fermentation in conical oak tanks for 15 days at a controlled temperature Malolactic fermentation in oak vats and barrels

Aging in oak containers of different sizes (barrels, casks, vats) for a period of 9 months.
