GEOGRAPHICAL ASPECTS:

Screws of Feteasca Neagra grow on a slightly hilly terrain with mixed composition of clay and limestone.

Coordinates: 45 ° 49' 51" N , 21 ° 35'19" E

Altitude: 220 m over sea level

Climate: Continental (-15°C in winter; +40°C in summer)

Soil: clay and limestone

Rainfall: 600 – 800 mm each year

VINEYARDS:

Varieties: Feteasca Neagra

Land management:

- Processes summer and autumn-winter green manure.
- The fertilization with green fertiliser foresees the cultivation of different herbaceous plants to enrich the soil with organic materials

Vineyard management:

- Work on the screws is performed manually.
- Weed control is mechanical and not chemical.

Cultivation system: Guyot system, with 6250 plants/ha

Production: 750 ml/plant

WINE CELLAR:

- Hand-picked grapes
- Manual sorting of the bunches and berries
- Fermentation in conical oak tanks for 15 days at a controlled temperature
- Malolactic fermentation in oak vats and barrels
- Aging in oak containers of different sizes (barrels, casks, vats) for a
